George Mason continues to enhance our performance management practices, reinforcing a culture of continuous feedback, engagement, and development. As we have entered the final quarter of the performance cycle, it's time to prepare for the annual performance evaluation process.

The self-evaluation period opens on **February 17, 2025**, giving employees and supervisors ample time to complete the process before the **April 30, 2025** deadline. All A/P faculty and Classified staff hired before **December 31, 2024** should participate as well as supervisors and indirect managers (assigned reviewers/proxies) of the aforementioned groups.

Here are a few highlights on the Performance Evaluation Process:

- 1. Self-Evaluations: Now open! Access through MasonLeaps. Due: March 2
 - Performance Evaluation Timeline can be found here

- 2. <u>Updated Rating Scale</u>: The following enhancements include...
- High-Performing rating is now included between Successful and Outstanding.
- Developing rating is reverting to Developing / Fair and will identify:
 Engaged performance that is moving toward demonstrating all required skills and abilities to become Successful OR employees who are now underperforming or not fully engaged in their work, which requires supervisory intervention.
- 3. Resources: GMU HR has variety of resources to provide guidance and support to employees and supervisors. Visit <u>Performance Evaluation Annual</u> <u>Guidance website</u> and <u>Performance Evaluation Resources website</u> (NOTE: VPN required to access) to explore all available resources.




